REHABILITATION OF THE LONG POINT CAUSEWAY FROM LAKESHORE ROAD TO ERIE BOULEVARD. INCLUDING THE REPLACEMENT OF THE LONG POINT CAUSEWAY BRIDGE OVER BIG CREEK

The Norfolk County and their consultant Parsons Inc., has initiated a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) for the rehabilitation of the Long Point Causeway, from Lakeshore Road to Erie Boulevard, as well as the replacement of the Long Point Causeway Bridge over Big Creek. The study is being undertaken to address deteriorating road and bridge conditions, as well as transportation needs along the Causeway.
